- *Community Expectations:* Make good choices with social media, Ask for help from a trusted adult, Respect people who are different from you, Respect people's personal space and privacy
- *Cafeteria Expectations:* Be polite & appreciative of others, Show kindness and concern for others
- *Hallway:* Help someone if they drop their things
- *Classroom:* Turn in assignments on time, Use appropriate language, Wait your turn to speak, Set a good example
- *Add location:* Social Media
 - Responsible: Think about your posts and how they will affect your not only today but in the future
 - Respectful: Do not post or support posts that will hurt others
 - Helpful: Report posts that harm others or the school
- Ways to Recognize Positive Behavior
