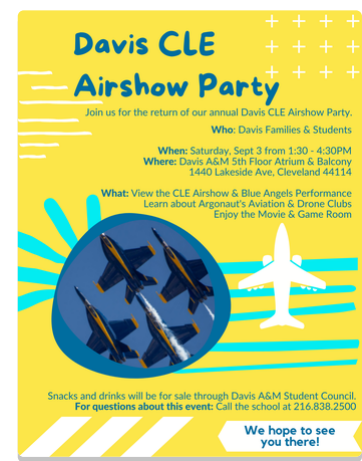
Join Us for the Davis CLE Airshow Party THIS SATURDAY

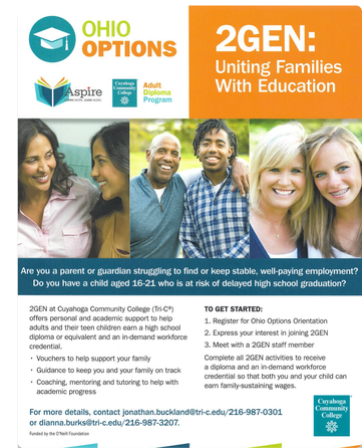
